ROAN PROFILE

Woranora Nobleman

Woranora Nobleman (aka Charlie or Charles) is a palomino roan Welsh Mountain Pony gelding born 22/11/2017 by the palomino roan stallion Imperial Behold and out of the chestnut roan mare Woranora Nara. Charlie is Nara's first foal and, like all her progeny, is proving to be an outstanding ridden pony following on from a very successful led career.

Charlie was purchased by Jessica Luscombe as a foal and hit the showring with a bang being extremely successful despite his smaller stature with his mature height still well under 11.2hh. He was a consistent winner in led classes with wins including Supreme Welsh Gelding at Canberra Royal and Supreme Led Exhibit Roan National Show. Charlie was sent to Victoria to be broken in by Taylah Lee and then came home to spell with the plan to have him ready for Jess' baby, Banksie, to eventually ride. He was then loaned to Maria Furina who has done the most amazing job with him.

In 2024, at his first Royal under saddle, Charlie was awarded Best Novice Show Hunter Pony at Sydney Royal, the first time this award has been won by a "small" pony. At this show he also qualified for the Child's Ridden at Grand National in 2025. He has only been lightly campaigned with his next state Royal being Canberra in February 2025 where he was awarded Champion Show Hunter Pony ne 12.2hh ridden by 7-year-old Elke Pledger. Charlie then went to Grand National, again partnered by Elke, and exceeded all expectations winning Champion Child's Hunter Pony and the Overall Grand Champion Child's Show Hunter exhibit. Charlie was not shown at Sydney Royal in 2025 and has just come back into work.

Apart from his showring successes, Charlie is also a lovely natured, if cheeky, member of Maria's family partnering her daughter Gracie in Tiny Tots and Beginner classes at shows and playing children's pony at home. As a young pony that has not been over shown or pushed it will be exciting to watch his progress in the future.

Minutes of the Roan Horse & Pony Society of Australia Inc

Annual General Meeting

Held 26th October 2024 Via Zoom

The Treasurer, Helen Dohan, declared the meeting open at 7.34pm AEST

Present: Helen Dohan, Lian Deschamps, Fran Langley, Kerrilyn Papworth, Linda Dowey, Anne Stephenson

Apologies: Nancy Lewis

Moved L Deschamps, seconded K Papworth 'That the minutes of the meeting held 29th December 2023 be noted as received.' Carried

Moved F Langley, seconded L Dowey 'That the minutes of the meeting held 29th December 2023 be approved.' Carried

Business Arising From The Minutes:

- Sydney Royal has not included any coloured classes for 2025, but Helen has written to the RAS requesting that should coloured classes be reinstated that Roans are also included.
- Canberra Royal – Canberra originally had no coloured classes for 2025 but have reinstated them on the first Tuesday. They have not added any other classes as they wish to see how the new timetable works. Helen has written to RNCAS requesting Roan classes for 2026.
- Term Deposit has been organized. \$10,000 invested with CBA at 4.5% to mature 15 March 2025. Will reinvest and add some if possible.
- Pointscore has been updated and is running. Pointscore information is sent to all new members. A Pointscore subcommittee would be good to assist Lian.
- Quarterly newsletters have been emailed to members and lapsed members, and Fran has been very active on our Facebook page. Previous newsletters are sent to all new members.
- Paula Byrnes has organized Highest Scoring sashes for registered Roans at the Western Dressage competitions and Kerrilyn is sending ribbons.



- Promotional banner has been ordered and if suitable we will get more for other states. Light grey with black writing 1800x900. The printer will also make us a high-resolution copy of the logo for \$25 as we only have low resolution.

Moved K Papworth, seconded L Deschamps 'That Business Arising from the minutes of 29th December 2023 be approved.' Carried

Presidents Report:

Helen Dohan tabled the report from Nancy Lewis.

Welcome to all our members who have joined us for our 2024 Annual General Meeting via Zoom. Another year has gone, and it is heartening to see we are progressing as a Society with memberships and registrations growing. From our members, we really look forward to your suggestions, requests and ideas; you personally can help with the continued growth of our Society. We would like to see more coordinators coming on board and for this we seek your assistance; it is not a demanding task but a very beneficial one. If you would like to nominate or have any other questions, please do not hesitate to contact your Roan committee. My very great thanks to our committee; without your hard work and total dedication we wouldn't be in the position we now enjoy.

Secretary's Report:

It is pleasing to see that membership and registration numbers are increasing. Sashes have been posted to a number of shows, especially in Victoria where Fran is doing an excellent job obtaining classes at shows. Sashes have also been posted to Queensland for the High Point Roan in Western Dressage that Paula Byrne has organized.

Treasurer/Registrar's Report:

- Helen Dohan presented the Income & Expenditure report for the year ending 30 June 2024. Current assets are ANZ account \$144.82, CBA main account \$12987.09, CBA debit account 235.54 as well as the CBA Term Deposit of \$10,000. When the money left in ANZ is used up in account keeping fees, the account will be closed, possibly before if people stop depositing into it. Term deposit to be renewed possibly with additional funds added.
- ANZ bank returned all the money lost through the scam and we ended up with a profit from that transaction.
- Due to the problems we encountered with the Homestead website, which was built on an old platform, the website has been moved to web.com and is currently paid up for two years. After this time, we will downgrade the package as we have more than is required. This will show as a significant expense in next year's balance sheet.
- ANZ Bank have just introduced an account keeping fee.



- At the moment there are 261 registered horses, and an additional 13 foal recorded horses and we have as many members now as we had at the end of the last membership year.

Moved H Dohan, seconded K Papworth 'That the Roan Society close the ANZ bank account.' Carried

Publicity Report:

- The Society has been generating considerable interest on Facebook with people now tagging Fran into posts regarding Roans, this all helps to increase the Society profile. There are now regular posts submitted by people advising what their Roans have achieved and also advertising them for sale. May try to do a Foal spread on Facebook or in the newsletter.
- Geelong Royal was excellent promotion with people commenting on the Roan presence.
- There are now 1100 members on our Facebook page.
- Try for Stud Profiles in the newsletter.

Pointscore Report:

There were a few more entries in the pointscore than last year with Lian contacting Qld members to encourage them to participate.

- A few problems were encountered with proposed solutions listed:
- Entries must be legible and sent via email to roanresults@gmail.com and not text or messenger
- All complete forms must be legible
- Lian will send confirmation of receipt of entries and forms.
- Pointscore results to be checked by a second person prior to prizes being ordered.
- Conditions of entry to be added to the entry form so everything is together.
- Members need to nominate which categories they are competing for, and a separate result sheet is required for each award.
- Where there are no Roan classes ie Colourama the points awarded will be as if it was a Roan class. Same if combined coloured classes.
- National awards as well as State would be good.
- Try to send people examples of how to complete forms.
- Try for a zoom or messenger meeting every three months.

Moved F Langley, seconded K Papworth 'That the Committee reports be approved.' Carried

General Business:

- Need to try to get a Qld State Show, maybe in conjunction with the Dilutes Show, and a Victorian State Show, maybe in conjunction with DEVA. Lian is working on Qld one and Fran on Victorian.



- Try to devise a State pointscore competition, State vs State.
- Need to push members to support classes when they are offered.
- Committee members spend a lot of their personal money promoting Roans and some no longer even have roans to compete.

Moved H Dohan, seconded A Stephenson 'That the membership fee for Roan Committee members as from 1/6/2025 be \$1.00 per year.' Carried

- Need to try to encourage studs to register their roans.

Moved K Papworth, seconded F Langley 'That a new member registering three or more roans at the time of membership application receive free membership for that year.' Carried

Moved L Deschamps, seconded K Papworth 'That General Business be approved.' Carried

Best Coloured of Show = 6 points

Open (not breed) classes at Royals, Harness Championships, Horse of the Year & equivalent events

1st=6 points, 2nd=4, 3rd=2, Champion=4, Reserve=2, Supreme=2, Champion Exhibit=6

Dressage Roan of the Year

points may be gained at any official or unofficial dressage test, English or Western, (closed gymkhanas excluded)

1st=6 points, 2nd=5, 3rd=4, 4th=3, 5th=2, 6th=1

Working Roan of the Year

points may be gained in events such as Reining, Cutting, Roping, Barrell Racing, any other Working Classes, (closed gymkhanas excluded)

1st=6 points, 2nd=5, 3rd=4, 4th=3, 5th=2, 6th=1, Champion =2, Reserve =1

Endurance Roan of the Year

points may be gained in Endurance, Training or Social Rides, Ride To Time Trials (photocopy of vet card or log book to accompany results) Successful completion required

Social – 5km=5 points, 10km=10, 20km=20 Training –

40km = 40 points

Endurance – 80km = 80 points, 100km=100

1st place – 50 bonus points, 2nd place – 30 bonus points, 3rd place – 20 bonus points Fittest horse

– 50 bonus points

Western Pleasure & Halter

Points may be gained in Western Halter and Western Saddle/Show classes

1st =6 points, 2nd =5, 3rd=4, 4th=3, 5th=2, 6th=1

Points may be gained at any Agricultural, Royal, Official Hack (eg EA, SHC, HHAA) or Breed/Colour Show.

At an event where exhibits are placed and then separately judged for a Championship: 1st =3, 2nd=2, 3rd=1point, Champion= 2 extra points, Reserve = 1 extra point

At an event where the class winner is declared Champion: Champion = 5, Reserve = 4, Top 5/Top 10 = 2
